She remains active on the Pacific Northwest National Lab advisory committee and the Renewable Energy Scholarship Fund.

As a consultant, Ms. Smith has advised clients on decarbonization strategies, renewable energy, and wildfire mitigation. She also served on the board of the Western Transmission Consortium and the Customer Advisory Council for a renewable energy company. A champion of transparency, accountability, and collaboration, Ms. Smith prioritizes customer needs while recognizing that great service starts with engaged employees.

Ms. Smith lives in Eugene, Oregon where she most enjoys spending time with her extended family – husband Dale, their five grown kids and three grandsons. Life is busy and wonderful.
